Knowledge sharing, a new way of creating value and increasing efficiency

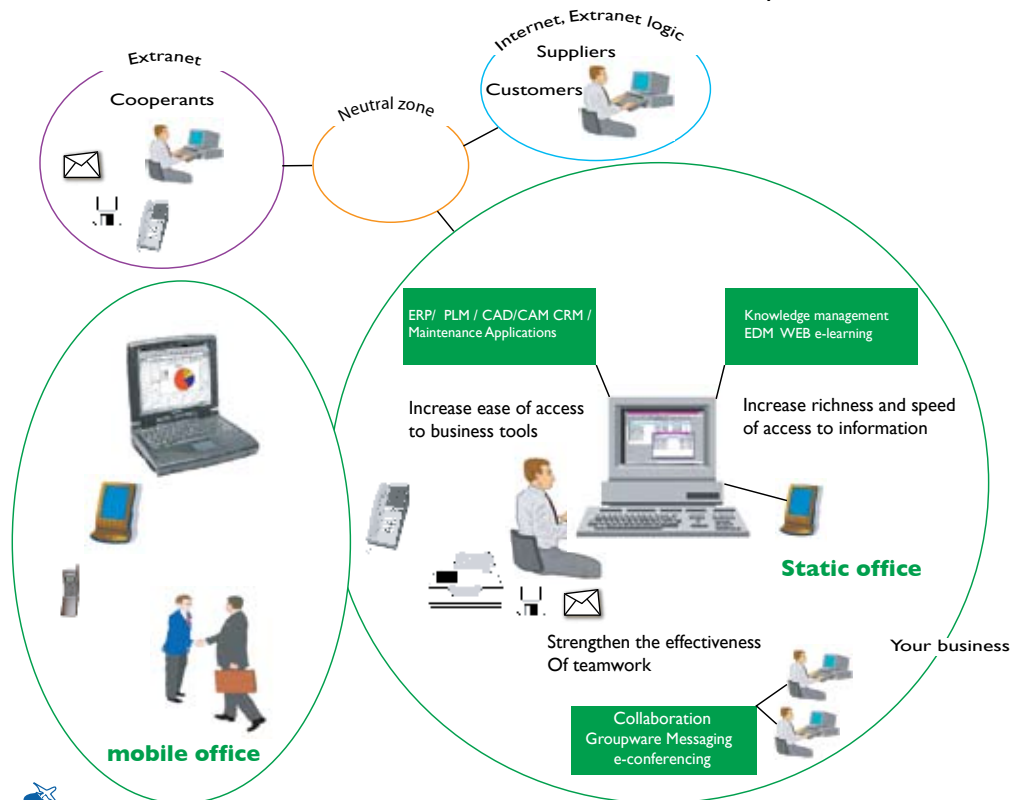
